

The FASC is using input from directors to adjust the 2021 season to support students and band directors post COVID. Considerations to adjusting contests included:

- Reducing the length of shows
 - Offering performance opportunities without the pressure of competition
 - Focus on the student experience and education
 - Offer more local shows due to travel limitation
 - Adjust numbers for divisions
 - When possible reduce costs

Considerations to hosting events

- Will schools be allowed to travel beyond their region?
 - Transportation limitations, how many students can be on one bus?
 - Audience limitations and size of stadium
 - Size of judges' box and ventilation
 - Judges' availability

Types of

Virtual

- Select venues for clinic
- Three judges per clinic: Music/Visual/Auxiliary
- In-person only
- Could take place at site to be used for ratings event later in the day
- Format/times and cost of clinics TBD
- Clinics could be given by non-judges, i.e. directors from in and out of the SoCal area
- Clear out stadium after 3-6 bands depending on size of program/CDC requirements/school district requirements, etc.


Clinics/ Ratings- *Sept 25- Oct. 16*


- 4 submission dates
- Ratings only – no scores
- Five judges per virtual evaluation: Music Performance/General Effect/Visual Performance/Auxiliary/Percussion
- Format used would be similar to current virtual festival format with turn-around time from receipt of video file to SCSBOA to return of adjudication to director in one week.
- Possible video streaming on private SCSBOA YouTube channel with permission of director

Virtual Evaluations


- To include weeknight events
- Five judges per panel: Music Performance/General Effect/Visual Performance/Auxiliary/Percussion
- Ratings events would begin in the “AM” portion of the event.
- A band could start their season with ratings and then change to the competitive option during the season.
- Use current score sheet format that will be adapted for ratings
- Recognition Ceremony
- No placement of bands/auxiliary/percussion

Ratings- *Sept. 25- Nov. 13*

- 
- As is common in festival adjudication directors may choose to perform for comments
 - The same judging panel and score sheets will be used
 - Participants will perform in the “AM” ratings portion of the event
 - Participants will be recognized at the “awards” ceremony
 - No placement of bands/auxiliary/percussion




Comments only- *Sept. 25- Nov. 13*



- May include weeknight events
- Five judges per panel: Music Performance/General Effect/Visual Performance/Auxiliary/Percussion
- Performance times would be after Ratings Divisions
- Use the same “newly adapted” Ratings score sheet
- Compete for awards
- Minimum of two competition format events to qualify for potential championships between October 23 and November 13

Traditional Competition- *Oct. 23-Nov. 13*

- 
- Two scores between Oct 23-Nov 13 will be used to qualify candidates for final event
 - The same scoring system used throughout the season will stay consistent
 - Pending on county regulations, travel limitations, audience guidelines, and district regulations will determine the type of culminating event SCSBOA can host.
 - County and or regional showcase may be offered instead of a traditional championship competition.
